

Suggested Sites for Volunteer Hours

Here are some ideas for parents and students. Please remember that parent/guardian hours should be for SLA or an SLA organized activity, with a total of 10 hours, per household, for the school year. Student hours should be a minimum of 5 hours per quarter, with a total of 20 hours for the year.

- Volunteering service to any non-profit organization, church, community organization or providing service/assistance to any non-family member within your community.
- Any SLA sponsored Service Project
- Boys and Girls Club
- YMCA
- Be a bell ringer for The Salvation Army during the Christmas season
- Special Olympics, Toys for Tots, any animal shelter.
- Visit the elderly at a Nursing home, bake or bring goodies to a Nursing home, Fire Dept., Police Dept., etc.
- Help with set up, break down and clean-up for school events.
- Chaperone a field trip or school dance.
- Participate in Coastal Clean Up or any other similar projects.
- Help at a local park, cleaning up trash or other help they may need.
- Participate with the school for Relay for Life, food drives, book fair, NJHS yard sale, etc. Community events will be announced at school as we get the information.
